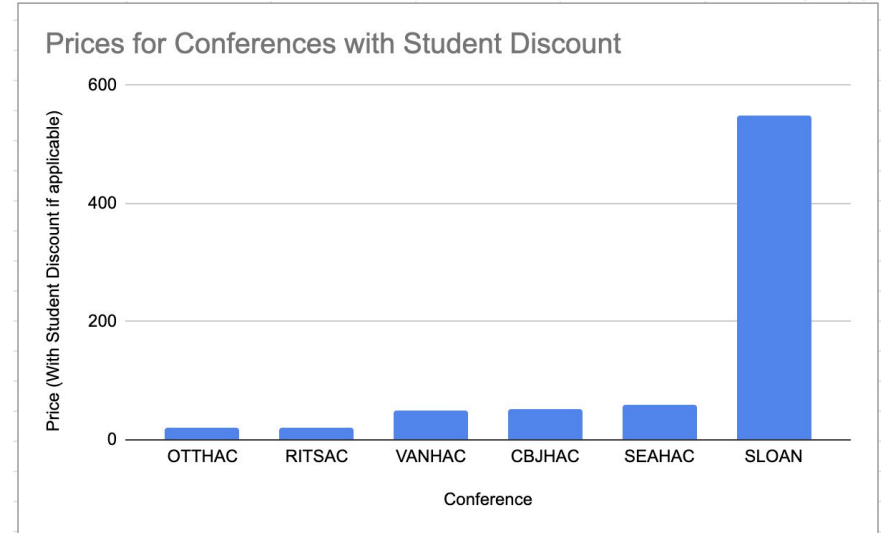
Lessons Learned From Planning the CBJHAC Diversity Initiative


